This is an official communication for the Beach Junior Double Gender event in Andorra.

We are pleased to inform that the National Volleyball Federation of Andorra will host the event. We urge all Small Countries Association members to stay directly in contact with Andorra for this event and register their teams.

Deadline for registration is July 25th 2019.

Age limit: Birthdate after 01/01/2001

Arrival date: August 15 and preliminary inquiry from 19.30 – 20.30 same day

Competition days: August 16 to 17 2019

Departure: August 18 2019

Pick up airport: Barcelona

Venue: Main venue: Andorra la Vella – “Parc Central”. Secondary venue Ordino (10 minutes by car). Semi-finals and Finals in “Parc Central”

Accommodation:

In an area of 600 meters close to “Parc Central” there is a wide range of hotels at very reasonable prices.

Medical services: The hospital with emergency service is two minutes by car from “Parc Central”. A physiotherapist will be at “Parc Central” to assist the players at the venue. ***We point at that all Europeans should have their own medical card issued by their respective Ministry of Health, in case needed.***

Transportation: A van service of the organization will be responsible for picking up the teams upon arrival at the Barcelona airport and transferring them to their hotels. The same service will be in place after the tournament finish to take care of teams departure to Barcelona. During the tournament a van service is in place for the teams between “Parc Central” and Ordino.

Medals and ceremony: The President of the Andorran Volleyball Federation, local authorities of Andorra la Vella and the Sports Department of the Government of Andorra will be present for the trophy ceremony. It will take place in “Parc Central” where the medal matches will take place after the last match of the tournament.

Referees: Beach Volleyball referees from the Catalan Volleyball Federation

Registration process:

The deadline for registration is by July 25th 2019. For the registration, the following information are required: Full name as provided for in the passport, date of birth, copy of the valid passport information via email to the Andorran Volleyball Federation fav@fav.ad.

An entry fee of 40€ per team will have to be paid to the organization before the preliminary inquiry.
